### PLAYERS

- I will be early for training and games.
- I will be at all training sessions and games. If there is an urgent issue and I can't train or play I will advise my Coach and Team Manager.
- I will work equally hard for myself and for my team. I will make every effort to shake my opponents hand after the game. I will be humble in victory and gracious in defeat.
- I will be a good sport and play by the rules (the club will not tolerate unsportsmanlike behaviour).
- I will arrive and leave the ground, and attend official functions as per the "published dress code" at all times and without exception.
- I will never argue with an official. If I disagree with a decision I will inform the captain, coach or manager during a break or after the game in an appropriate manner. I will not raise issues of disagreement publicly.
- I will control my temper and not use derogatory or bad language.
- I will treat all players in my sport as I like to be treated. I will not bully or take unfair advantage of another competitor.
- I will cooperate with my coach, team members and opponents.
- I will not criticise or ridicule any teammate's performance before, during or after the game.
- I will not arrive at the venue under the influence of drugs or alcohol nor will I consume drugs or alcohol at games.
- I will respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in the game, regardless of their gender, ability or cultural background.
- If I breach any aspect of the code of conduct, I understand that the club may stand me down as a player or terminate my registration with the club.

### PARENTS

- I won't pressure my child in any way – I know that this is their game not mine.
- I will not shout advice to players during the game (the coach provides instructions to the players and my comments may be in contradiction to these guidelines).
- I will not use bad language, nor will I harass players, coaches, officials or other spectators.
- I will encourage my child to play within the rules and respect officials and coaches decisions – no matter what.
- I will teach my child to respect the efforts of their opponents.
- I will recognise and acknowledge all good play for both teams, not just my own child.
- I will not criticise the coach in front of my child. I will support the coach and stand by his/her decisions.
- I will not criticise or ridicule my child's performance before, during or after the game.
- I will not criticise or ridicule any other child's performance before, during or after the game.
- I will volunteer my services and help when asked by a coach, manager or official.
- I will not arrive at the venue under the influence of drugs or alcohol nor will I consume drugs or alcohol at games.
- I will respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in the game, regardless of their gender, ability or cultural background.
- If I, or any relative of the player, breach any aspect of the code of conduct, I understand that the club may stand down my child as a player or terminate their registration with the club. I also understand that any breaches may result in a spectator ban at future games.
- I understand that any fines imposed by Football NSW as a result of my behaviour will be payable by myself and, if not paid, the player may be stood down until such fines are paid in full.
